To whom it may concern,

This letter serves as a Drainage Conformance Letter for the Parker salt shed addition at the Parker Adventist Hospital. This letter references the Final Drainage and Erosion Control Report for the Parker Adventist Hospital, prepared by S. A. Miro, Inc., dated May 1, 2002. The latest update to the report was for the Parking Lot a, prepared by S. A. Miro, Inc., dated March, 2018.

The purpose of this letter is to demonstrate the existing storm sewer facilities serving the improvements for the Parker Adventist Hospital can convey the runoff generated by the proposed salt shed. The salt shed and driveway has an impervious footprint of approximately 800 sf, generating a negligible amount of runoff. Stormwater generated by this project is tributary to the on-site detention pond A, which has capacity available for all runoff generated by the salt shed.
