The District has reviewed the construction efforts of maintenance eligible features for the referenced project. The work visually appears to be completed in reasonable conformance with the approved construction plans and specifications. Therefore, construction of maintenance eligible features is hereby approved, which completes Step 2 out of 3 in the MEP process.

This construction acceptance is based upon visual inspection of those elements of the project which are visible to the naked eye. This acceptance should not be construed as a certification of the structural integrity of any component of the project. Site visit records can be obtained with a written request.

The last step in the MEP process is final acceptance. A final acceptance letter (MEP Step 3 of 3), which signifies certification of maintenance eligibility, will be issued upon establishment of adequate vegetative cover. It is the responsibility of the local government to notify the District in writing when adequate vegetation exists, which may or may not coincide with the closing out of various permits related to the project (i.e., erosion control, wetland, floodplain development, etc.). Once a written request is submitted to the District, the District will arrange to inspect the site with you or another representative to make our determination. Final acceptance of maintenance eligible features will be documented with a final acceptance letter.
